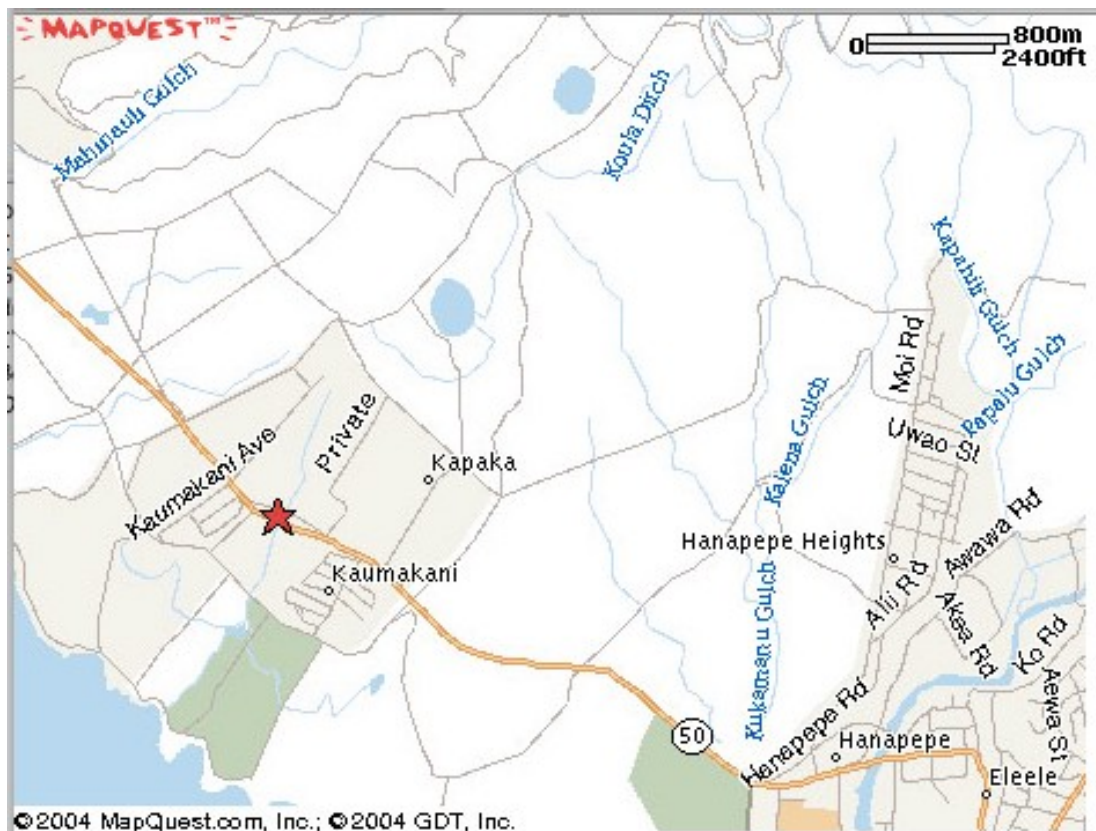

K.E.A.S.A. presents a Monthly Public Starwatch  
Kaumakani Park & Sports Pavilion  
(Behind Kaumakani Neighborhood Center)  
Starts at Sunset



From Lihue, follow highway 50 west, past Hanapepe. Just past Thrifty Bakery (on the left - Makai), bear RIGHT at the fork. Sign says “Kaumakani School.” Just before the buildings, follow the dirt road on the right up to the ball field. Parking adjacent to the fence line. (PLEASE DIM YOUR HEADLIGHTS when approaching the ball field, & park with your headlights facing AWAY from the field.) We’ll be set up near the pavilion end of the ball field.

Bring a light jacket, hat, and/or other warm clothing for chilly nights, a beach or lawn chair, PLUS a mat, towel or blanket to sit on, and a small flashlight, for everyone in your party, if possible. (Note: White light from cell phones does NOT work well for stargazing). Insect repellent is recommended.
